

Decision No. 186

A (No. 2),  
Applicant

v.

International Bank for Reconstruction and Development,  
Respondent

1. The World Bank Administrative Tribunal has been seized of an application, received on February 28, 1997, by A against the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development. The case has been decided by a Panel of the Tribunal, established in accordance with Article V(2) of its Statute, composed of F. Orrego Vicuña (a Vice President of the Tribunal) as President, Thio Su Mien and Bola A. Ajibola, Judges.

2. By letter dated April 24, 1998 the Applicant's attorney informed the Tribunal that "the Respondent offered to pay [the Applicant's] legal costs if she would withdraw her Application" and that the Applicant "ha[d] decided to accept Respondent's offer and withdraw her Application."

3. By letter dated April 27, 1998 the Respondent confirmed "that it ha[d] offered to pay Applicant's attorney's fees and costs ... in full and final settlement of her claim; that Applicant ha[d] accepted the offer and ha[d] agreed to withdraw her Application in return; and that Respondent concur[red] with Applicant's withdrawal of her Application."

**DECISION**

Considering that the application is withdrawn, the Tribunal unanimously decides to record the withdrawal of the application.
