1. On 14 January 2014, the Tribunal received an Application filed by the Applicant against the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development.
2. By an e-mail message dated 15 September 2014, the Applicant informed the Tribunal that she had “completed [her] case with Peer Review Services and [is] satisfied with the outcome” and that she would “no longer wish to proceed with the case.” In the same e-mail message, she also requested that “due to the sensitivity of the nature of the case, [she] would like to request anonymity for any future reference to [her] case.”
3. By a letter to the Tribunal dated 18 September 2014, the Bank notified the President of the Tribunal that it had no objection to the Applicant’s request to end the proceedings and to her request for anonymity.
4. The Tribunal has decided to grant the Applicant’s request for anonymity and dismiss the Application.
