Order No. 2001-2

1. The World Bank Administrative Tribunal received on August 1, 2001 an application from Judith Snavelly McGuire against the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development. On October 18, 2001, the Tribunal granted a request made by the Respondent that the case be suspended for 30 days pending settlement discussions.

2. By a letter to the Tribunal dated November 9, 2001, the Applicant requested the withdrawal of her application. By a letter of November 15, 2001 to the Tribunal, the Respondent confirmed its consent to the withdrawal.
