

Decision No. 102

Jean-Michel Verdier,
Applicant

v.

International Bank for Reconstruction and Development,
Respondent

1. World Bank Administrative Tribunal, composed of P. Weil, President, A.K. Abul-Magd and E. Lauterpacht, Vice Presidents, and F.K. Apaloo, R.A. Gorman, E. Jimenez de Arechaga and Tun Suffian, Judges, has been seized of an application, received July 16, 1990, by Jean-Michel Verdier, against the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development.

2. By letter, dated April 16, 1991, and received by the Executive Secretary on April 24, 1991, the Applicant informed the Tribunal that "having entered into a full and final settlement with the Bank of all claims, I wish to withdraw the application filed on my behalf..."

3. By letter, dated and received by the Executive Secretary on April 26, 1991, the Respondent confirmed "that it has entered into a full settlement with Mr. Jean-Michel Verdier as described by him in his letter to the Tribunal dated April 16, 1991" and requested that the Tribunal dismiss the application.

Decision:

Considering that the application is withdrawn, the Tribunal unanimously decides to record the withdrawal of the application.
