ORDER

1. The World Bank Administrative Tribunal, composed of E. Lauterpacht, President, R.A. Gorman and F. Orrego Vicuña, Vice Presidents, and P. Weil, A.K. Abul-Magd, Thio Su Mien and Bola A. Ajibola, Judges, has been seized of an application, received on February 20, 1997, against the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development.
2. The Applicant had submitted an earlier application to this Tribunal which resulted in a judgment rendered on November 9, 1995 (Decision No. 146 [1995]).
3. As it appeared to the President that the present application was devoid of all merit, pursuant to paragraph 11 of Rule 7 of the Rules of the World Bank Administrative Tribunal, he instructed the Executive Secretary to take no further action thereon until the next session of the Tribunal.
4. Having considered the present application at its session of April 1997, the Tribunal concludes that it is devoid of all merit as it is essentially repetitive of, and indistinguishable from, the earlier application.

Decision:

The Tribunal unanimously decides that the application be summarily dismissed.
