- 1. On 6 February 2020, the Tribunal received an Application filed by the Applicant against the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development. In his Application, the Applicant made a request for anonymity. The Bank did not object to the request.
- 2. By letter to the Tribunal dated 10 December 2020, a copy of which was transmitted to the Bank on 10 December 2020, the Applicant requested the withdrawal of his Application, stating "The parties have agreed to a complete and final settlement of all issues in the Application." On 7 January 2021, the Bank concurred with the Applicant's request.
- 3. On the basis of the settlement of the claims between the Bank and the Applicant, the Tribunal deems it appropriate to dismiss this case.
- 4. The Tribunal grants the Applicant's request for anonymity.
