1. On 19 November 2020, the Tribunal received an Application filed by the Applicant against the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development. An amended Application was received on 20 November 2020.

2. By letter to the Tribunal dated 30 March 2021, a copy of which was transmitted to the Bank on 31 March 2021, the Applicant requested the withdrawal of his Application, stating that "the matters raised by [the] Applicant in the [...] case have been settled through Mediation." On 14 April 2021, the Bank informed the Tribunal it "has no objection to [the] Applicant's request to withdraw his Application."

3. On the basis of the settlement of the claims between the Bank and the Applicant, the Tribunal deems it appropriate to dismiss this case.

4. The Tribunal grants the Applicant anonymity.

The Application is dismissed.
