- 1. On 14 April 2021, the Tribunal received an Application filed by the Applicant against the Bank.
- 2. By letter to the Tribunal dated 20 July 2021, a copy of which was transmitted to the Bank on 21 July 2021, the Applicant requested the withdrawal of his Application "in light of resolution of his dispute with [the Bank]." On 26 July 2021, the Bank concurred with the Applicant's request.
- 3. On the basis of the settlement of the claims between the Bank and the Applicant, the Tribunal deems it appropriate to dismiss this case.
- 4. The Tribunal grants the Applicant anonymity.
